

**Glenella – School Plan for Level ORANGE Pandemic Planning**  
**Grades Junior Kindergarten to Grade 12**  
 \*subject to change based on public health guidance\*\*

Details	Level Orange – Blended Learning
<b>Participants</b>	<p>In-class learning is suspended. Teacher led remote learning with some limited use of schools</p> <p>Teacher-directed remote learning will be an essential component of K to 12 education throughout the pandemic. When remote learning is needed, students may work independently on their own, as well as work with a teacher in real time.</p> <p>Blended in-class and remote learning plans may need to be implemented on short notice and may be in response to isolation due to illness from exposures.</p>
School Day Structure	
<b>Timetables</b>	<p>Students will be at home learning            in-class learning will be suspended, but school facilities may be used for specific programming, following the guidelines for the limited use of school facilities.</p> <p>Teachers will set times to meet with students</p>
<b>Arrival/Dismissal</b>	<p>Students scheduled to work from the building will use the front entrance and will be buzzed in and screened using the COVID screening tool.</p> <p>Students will leave by the front door.</p> <p>Students will hand sanitize and will be required to log entry and exit from the building.</p> <p>Students will be met at the front door and walked to classroom by teacher,.</p>

<b>Movement of Students</b>	<p>Students will be meet at the front door by teacher or staff.</p> <p>Staff will escort students to the designated classroom.</p> <p>Students will be reminded not to touch the walls walking down the hallway</p>
<b>Academic Program</b>	
<b>Classroom Configuration</b>	<p>Desks will be spaced 2 meters apart</p> <p>Outdoor learning is encouraged</p>
<b>Instruction</b>	<p>The focus will be on the teaching of outcomes, rather than the amount of time per subject ( a cross curricular approach is recommended)</p> <p>Use TEAMS to ensure student familiarity for changing learning scenarios. Use of SEE SAW by K-4</p> <p>Curriculum focus is essential learning in math, ELA, science, and Social Studies</p> <p>Small group instruction in class</p>
<b>Assessment and Reporting</b>	<p>In class assessment through small groups</p> <p>In elementary key assessments, (Fountas and Pinnell and reading) completed early in school year</p> <p>Provincial assessments in early years and middle years are cancelled for the year</p> <p>At this time Grade 12 Provincial exams will still be completed</p> <p>Divisions assessment will be looked at closer to the time</p> <p>Report cards will be completed</p> <p>Use of parent portal is encouraged</p>

<b>School Supplies and Personal Belongings</b>	Students will have their supplies at home and only bring in the essential supplies.
<b>Alternate Learning Spaces</b>	
<b>Gym</b>	Physical activities will be encouraged at home
<b>Library</b>	Library will not be used during this time
<b>Common Area/Canteen</b>	Will be off limit to students unless needed to allow for physical distancing
<b>Transition to school in the fall</b>	Students will be learning from home
<b>Student Well-Being</b>	<p>Teachers will check in with families and students on a regular basis.</p> <p>Staff are to self-monitor and stay home if ill</p> <p>Parents will screen students before coming into the school</p>
<b>Computers:</b>	<p>Students will be working at home with their personal device</p> <p>If no personal device available, students will have the opportunity to sign out school computers</p> <p>If using a device at school devices will be assigned, it will be sanitized between use</p> <p><b>**Turtle River School Division and Glenella School are not responsible for lost or damaged tech. devices**</b></p>
